

2018 Residential Outcome Payments Announcement

June 6, 2018

Greetings,

Inclusa is excited to announce the available opportunities surrounding the 2018 residential outcome-based payments, which eligible providers are able to receive as part of our current Residential Rate Methodology (RRM)*. These outcomes allow you to receive an additional payment when meeting certain criteria designed to promote member success; payments are based on offering an additional level of care that is not captured within other areas of the Rate Methodology. The outcome payment amounts will be determined in the Fall of 2018 when Inclusa receives its capitation rate from the State; payments will then be distributed to eligible providers in the Spring of 2019 via member authorization(s) found within the Provider Portal.

*Please Note: The 2018 Residential Outcome Payment opportunities are available to only those contracted residential providers utilizing the 2018 RRM; providers who support Day Services, Supportive Homecare Days, Supportive Apartments, or the like, are not eligible as the 2018 RRM is not utilized to determine those rates. All eligible providers must remain in good standing with Inclusa throughout the project year as determined by Inclusa, and any payments may be offset to providers who have an outstanding balance due to Inclusa or any of its Legacy Managed Care Organizations (MCOs).

Behavioral Health: Dementia Care Toolkit

Description:

Over the past four years, MCOs have been working closely with the State to improve dementia care within our communities. With the State's dementia redesign, an area of interest has included improving long term care options for people with challenging behaviors, or for those who use behavior as a method of communication. As part of this year's Behavioral Health Outcome, providers will be encouraged to utilize a *Dementia Care Toolkit*, which was previously developed in partnership with providers. The resources within the *Dementia Care Toolkit* assist providers and caregivers to support those who communicate using behaviors, specifically those who are diagnosed with a form of Dementia.

To be eligible to receive this outcome payment:

- 1. Have one or more members residing in your facility with a dementia target flag on the Long Term Care Functional Screen (LTCFS) who currently have rates calculated through Inclusa's 2018 Residential Rate Methodology
- Submit application to participate and agree to terms and conditions of outcome by the deadline of July 1, 2018
- 3. Review at least two webinar trainings and complete associated questions with a passing score; one of the completed webinars must consist of the "Dementia Care Toolkit: How To"
- 4. Submit completed Dementia Care Toolkit by deadline of December 1, 2018 to innovation@inclusa.org
 - a. Completed Toolkits can be submitted at any time prior to December 1, 2018

Quality Improvement: Best Practice Initiative

Description:

Inclusa will make an additional payment to eligible providers for projects that will improve the quality of services currently offered and have a positive impact on current members. This initiative allows you to identify a specific project related to quality best practices.

To be eligible to receive this outcome payment:

- 1. **Have one or more members residing in your facility** who currently have rates calculated through Inclusa's 2018 Residential Rate Methodology
- Submit application to participate and agree to Terms and Conditions of outcome by the deadline of July 1, 2018
- 3. **Complete and submit progress** reports on project by completing questionnaires throughout the year via online platform, by deadline dates of **September 5, 2018** and **December 5, 2018**

Health Promotion: Influenza Prevention & Education

Description:

Seasonal influenza (commonly known as the flu) is a contagious respiratory illness caused by influenza viruses that infect the nose, throat, and lungs. The single **BEST** way to prevent the flu is to get a flu vaccine **EACH** year. Inclusa will make an additional payment to providers who demonstrate a commitment to ensuring their residents are provided options for gaining access to flu clinics and influenza education.

To be eligible to receive this outcome payment:

- 1. **Have one or more members residing in your facility** who currently have rates calculated through Inclusa's 2018 Residential Rate Methodology
- 2. **Accurately complete all areas of the spreadsheet** provided to you in the fall of 2018, keeping in mind, members still have the right to refuse the vaccination
- Submit completed spreadsheet and agree to terms and conditions of outcome by deadline of December 1, 2018
 - a. Providers will still receive credit for members who refuse/decline the vaccination

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Outcome Deadline:

All documentation will need to be submitted by December 1, 2018, to be eligible for this outcome
payment
