—3 Stages Of Interviews



Before the interview



Always make sure you execute in depth research



Bring an extra copy of your resume, keep it tidy in a folder



Know exactly where it is you're going – do a test run the day before



Turn your phone off



During the interview



Make a good first impression by dressing well, giving firm handshakes and smiling



Be prepared to tell them about yourself – come ready with a story that shows off your personality and relevant skills



Stay positive – don't get baited into negative subjects or talking down on people



Leave the subject of money until the interview gets flowing, you don't want to ask this during the early parts of an interview

Make sure you research what your salary should be and have facts to back yourself up



After the interview



Always send a thank you letter – even if it went bad



Don't talk about the interview on social media
